On-Line Search for General Education Courses

The Advanced Class Search of the on-line Class Schedule enables students and advisors to search the schedule of classes to find classes which satisfy GE requirements for a specific semester. The search also allows looking for specific areas of competency within the GE requirements.

To use the GE search feature:

1. Log in <http://my.csufresno.edu> and navigate to **Search Class Schedule**
2. select the Term. Click the **GO** button.
3. Go to bottom of screen and click on **Additional Search Criteria**.
4. Enter **GEA** in the **Course Attribute box**.
5. Click on the magnifying glass for the **Course Attr. Value** to select the value for the General Education area being searched. (see values and areas listed below)
6. Click **Search**. The results displayed can then be used in the registration process.

Note: Any of the other fields on the Advanced Class Search page can be used to narrow the focus of the search.
