1. The meeting was called to order by Allen Gaad at 2:05 pm.
2. Rod Gleghorn moved to accept the agenda. Dave Moll seconded the acceptance and the motion carried.
3. Rod Gleghorn motioned to accept the minutes from the April 22, 2009 meeting. Dave Mowry seconded and the motion carried.
4. Driving on the Sidewalks (DOTS) committee update

Dave Moll reported that the DOTS committee has met a couple of times now and are working on putting together an operational plan to keep vehicles out of the campus core. They have discussed where the restrictions will apply and are currently working on:

- Who will be allowed to drive
- When they will be allowed to drive
- How to enforce
- Vendor notification

The committee should have a draft ready to present by the next Traffic & Safety Subcommittee meeting in June.

5. Barstow and Price stop signs.

Dave Mowry needed confirmation from the committee regarding the striping and exactly where the eastbound trap lane needs to begin and end. He and Rod will have a proposal prepared for the June meeting. Discussion continued regarding the removal of the Barstow and Price stop signs with the probability of removing them during the summer session and installing a temporary barricade with a supplemental sign for one month indicating that “cross traffic does not stop”. John Hung inquired as to the installation of a concrete stop to deter left turns from eastbound Barstow for access to Lot T. The committee did not feel it would be necessary.

6. Other items

Allen Gaad reported that the city is scheduled to begin removal of the dip at Barstow and Cedar sometime mid to late June with completion by mid July.

Dave Moll shared a recent complaint brought to the campus planning and safety committee by the president of the council of disabilities concerning parking lot potholes. This could be a potential safety issue for the disabled particularly where wheelchairs are concerned. Allen Gaad, Dave Moll, Rod Gleghorn and John Hung will schedule a pothole patrol to identify the problem areas on campus and submit the appropriate work orders to Plant Operations to fix the potholes.
