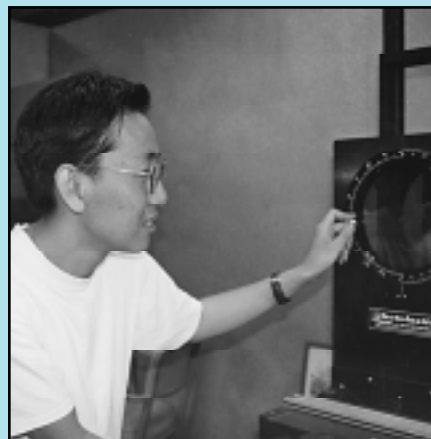
To reach these goals, the College of Engineering and Computer Science provides excellent scholarship support for students and maintains a computer system with 150 student workstations.
