

## COMMUNITY SERVICE 1 REGISTRATION

**Fall 2009**

The Community Service 1 (Com S 1) – Community Service-Learning course is designed to give students the opportunity to receive academic credit in exchange for volunteer service. Through community service-learning you can significantly enhance your personal, professional and academic development, while contributing to the community in which you live. Since there are hundreds of nonprofit agencies available, you can choose the organization that best fits your needs, interests, and schedule.

Students will meet for approximately one hour each week throughout the semester. In-class reading and writing assignments may be required along with a final paper and/or project. Grading is on a Credit/Non-credit basis only. A sample course syllabus can be found on the CESL website at <http://www.csufresno.edu/cesl>. The following are the total service hours required for Com S 1:

1 unit = 15 hours + weekly class meeting  
2 units = 30 hours + weekly class meeting  
3 units = 60 hours + weekly class meeting

The course is open to all students and can be used for elective credits towards graduation. You can register for Com S 1 through the *STAR* registration system. The registration numbers for the course sections are as follows:
