

New Horizons Band/Orchestra for Seniors!

Are you 50 years old or older? It's never too late to begin learning how to play a band or string instrument or to dust off your old instrument and start playing again. Perhaps you want to learn how to play yet another instrument. As a beginner, you will receive group lessons and participate in a beginner band. If you have previous musical experience, you will play in an advanced band. At the end of the semester, your band/orchestra will present a concert to the community.

As a member of New Horizons Band/Orchestra, you will meet new friends and work with them as a team to learn music for concerts and other performances in the community. New Horizons ensembles typically perform many times each year in venues ranging from formal concerts to shopping malls to parks to retirement and nursing homes.

It's Easy and Fun!

As an adult you have advantages that will help you learn music. If you played an instrument in school years ago, you will be amazed at how much you remember and how quickly you will be able to play again. Even if you've never played music, you are already familiar with the sound of a lot of the music that will be included in your early instruction.



Getting Started

The first step in getting started is attending an informational meeting on September 2, 6:30 - 8:30 p.m., in the Kremen Education Building, Room 140, during which all of your questions will be answered by a music teacher and music dealer. You will also have a chance to meet some of the other people who will be participating.

- Re-learn to play the instrument that you played earlier in life
- Choose an instrument that has a sound or a look that you like
- Check with the band director to see which instrument is needed in the band

Class meets on the Fresno State campus on Wednesday nights, 5:30 - 8:30 p.m. (string instruments start at 5:30 p.m.; band instruments start at 6:30 p.m.) beginning September 9 and ending December 9 (no class on Nov. 11 & 25). The fee is \$150 for the entire semester (13 class meetings). Director and Conductor Archie Rader has spent the last 55 years teaching instrumental music.
