Winter Interession FAQs

Who can register for Interession classes?

Matriculated Fresno State students. Students who have been disqualified from Fresno State. Students who are 18 years old or older and who have met the class prerequisites. Students who have never taken a Fresno State class previously.

When will the schedule be out?

Monday, October 12. It will be available in the Collegian and printed copies can be found in the Madden Library, Kennel Bookstore, Student Union, Student Advisement Center, and Learning Resource Center. It will also be posted on our website: www.csufresno.edu/cge/interession

When can I register?

Register beginning October 26 through December 1, 2009. Register online at www.csufresno.edu/cge/interession or in person at Continuing and Global Education, Kremen Education Building, Room 130. We're open from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Closed November 25-30, and closed from December 24-January 4.

How many units may I take?

Students are limited to 4 units in Interession. Matriculated students who wish to take excess units may complete the excess units petition on our website (www.csufresno.edu/cge/forms) and obtain the signature of their academic dean. Non-matriculated students use the same form, and obtain the signature of the Associate Vice President for Continuing and Global Education.

Will an Interession class count toward my degree?

Interession classes earn resident credit. Ask your advisor if the class will meet your specific degree requirements.

How much are the fees and when are they due?

Fees are \$286 per unit and are due at the time of registration. Non-payment of fees cancels your online registration within 24 hours. Paying the fees holds your place in class.

What is the chance of my course being cancelled?

If a class has insufficient enrollment, it will be cancelled. On Monday, December 7, the list of cancelled classes will be posted on the Continuing and Global Education website: www.csufresno.edu/cge/interession. If your class is cancelled, you may enroll in a different Interession class, or you may request a refund.

When will my grade be posted?

Grades can be accessed after January 29, 2010, at my.csufresno.edu

What student services will be in operation during Interession?

The Kennel Bookstore, Madden Library, Health and Psychological Services and some Food Court restaurants will be open, but perhaps with reduced hours. Parking is free in the green lots.
