THE PROGRAM

Through site visits and lectures, participants in this travel study program will examine The Netherlands' criminal justice system and the country's culture and history. Special emphasis will deal with the psychology of penal institutions, role of treatment in offender rehabilitation, incarceration and punishment of adults and juveniles, drug enforcement, and the administration of the law.

PROGRAM FEE

The fee of \$2,599 includes:

- roundtrip airfare from Los Angeles, California to Amsterdam, via KLM
- transfers to and from Schiphol Airport in Amsterdam
- hotel accommodations (double occupancy) in the first-class 4 star Amsterdam-Memphis Hotel for 6 nights
- full breakfast daily
- half-day city sightseeing tour of Amsterdam on board a luxurious coach where participants will see the Royal Palace, the National Monument, the Skinny Bridge, the Albert Cuijp Market, beautiful homes along the canals, a windmill on the River Amstel, a diamond factory, and experience a boat tour along Amsterdam's harbor and its famous canals
- hotel portage for one piece of luggage from hotel to airport and return; taxes; and service charges
- one unit of credit

What's Excluded: Travel medical insurance (medical insurance is required of all participants and must be purchased by March 1, 2010 at www.csuhealthlink.com for approximately \$22); passport; meals and drinks not specified above; and any tips for porters, tour leaders, drivers, waitresses, and hotel staff.

Fee Payment Schedule

- \$600 program fee deposit due by December 4, 2009 to Travel Shoppe
- \$150 course fee deposit due by December 4, 2009 to Fresno State
- \$150 course fee balance due by March 1, 2010 to Fresno State
- \$1,699 program fee balance due March 1, 2010 to Travel Shoppe

Refund Schedule: For cancellations received through March 9, 2010, 50% of all fees paid will be refunded. Beginning March 10, 2010 there is no refund.

All major expenses are covered by the fee except meals, transportation in Amsterdam, and personal incidentals. Airfare taxes and fuel surcharges are subject to change until tickets are issued on March 10, 2010. Any fee increases will be passed on to the participant. If the group consists of fewer than 20 persons, the fee may increase or the program may be cancelled. If you do not have a roommate, and we cannot find one for you, a single room supplement of \$475 will be required. An optional alternative return date is available at no extra charge, pending flight availability. PLEASE NOTE: Any expenses that a participant incurs after the program ends on June 3, 2010 are not covered by the program fee. No accommodations, hotels, transportation or other expenses are provided for participants choosing to extend their stay in Europe. Participants are on their own for sightseeing and tourism as they wish, although Cheri Verraastro at Travel Shoppe is available to help participants plan and make reservations for independent travel during this period. Program size is limited; therefore, early reservations are strongly encouraged. Contact the Travel Shoppe for an optional \$150 per person Travel Protection Plan which covers cancellations due to illness of you or an immediate family member, trip interruption, travel delay, and travel accidents or medical situations. A passport valid for at least 6 months and in good condition is required for travel to The Netherlands. Any disability requiring special attention must be reported to Travel Shoppe at the time of booking. Any alterations or revisions made later than 120 days prior to departure will be subject to a fee for each transaction at Travel Shoppe's discretion.

California State University, Fresno will adhere to all rules and regulations regarding airfare refunds established by the airlines for any cancellation. Notification of cancellation must be submitted in writing to the Division of Continuing and Global Education.
