

## **Certificate in Alcohol/Drug Studies**

A certificate of special study is awarded to those students who successfully complete a minimum of 12 units of interdisciplinary academic coursework in the area of alcohol and drug abuse. Students seeking the certificate:

1. must have completed two years of college or two years of experience related to the field of alcohol/drug abuse, and
2. must be regularly enrolled in the university.

All coursework must be taken for a letter grade and completed with a grade of C or better in each of the 9 required units and the 3 units of electives. The following list includes the course requirements for the certificate:

HS 111: Alcohol and Alcoholism

SWRK 129: Treatment of Chemical Dependency

### **Elective(s) (3 units)**

Select 3 units from the following listings:

WS 115: Women, Children, and Alcohol (1 unit)

WS 150T: Women and Alcohol (1 unit)

CRIM 190, HS 190, SWRK 190, or WS 190: Independent Study on selected aspects of alcohol/drug abuse (1 unit)
