**English**

The university has implemented changes to the first-year writing program starting Fall 2006. In the new first-year writing program, students enroll in either Engl 5A (a stretched course) or Engl 10 (an accelerated one-semester course). Students who enroll in 5A will also enroll in Engl 5B in the following semester. Engl 10 and the two semester Engl 5A and 5B sequence replace English 1.
