ENGINEER I

The Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District has an immediate opening for an Engineer I. Primary duties include the development and modifications to the District's rural storm drainage master plans. May also include the review and approval of urban development proposals for consistency with storm drainage and flood control master plans. The position also requires performing a variety of engineering studies, flood routing, hydrology and hydraulics calculations, and other duties as needed including basic surveying and field work.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum qualifications include a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering with specialization in hydraulics and hydrology plus one year work experience in a related field. Familiarity of pipeline and open channel design and flood control methods, operations and construction is desirable. Experience with Hec-Ras, Hec-Hms and Hec-1 is desirable but training will be provided. New graduates with specialization in hydraulics and hydrology will be considered. Engineer-in-training (EIT) certification may be substituted for the college degree. A valid California Driver's License is required.

EXCELLENT FRINGE BENEFITS

Benefits include District-paid employee and dependent health benefits, including medical, dental and vision, Annual Leave program (vacation/sick pay), eleven paid holidays, 457 deferred compensation plan, District-funded money purchase pension plan, AFLAC products, and participation in the District's cafeteria plan for reimbursement of out-of-pocket medical and dependent care expenses.
