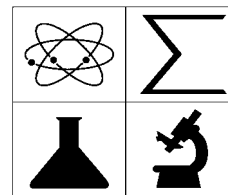


MESA DAY CONTEST RULES 2003-2004



Crystal Growing

LEVEL:	Senior High School
TYPE OF CONTEST:	Individual/Team
COMPOSITION OF TEAMS:	1 - 2 students per team
NUMBER OF TEAMS:	3 teams per Center
SPONSOR:	Vonna Hammerschmitt, Director, CSU Fullerton MSP Center

OVERVIEW: Students will grow the largest, best-formed crystal.

MATERIALS: Water; any water-soluble compound; beaker or glass jar; thread or string; craftstick or pencil.

SAFETY NOTE: This competition uses some hazardous materials. Please exercise caution and when necessary use safety goggles and gloves. Take all other precautions as required (e.g. MSDS).

RULES: (Omission of any of these elements will result in disqualification)

- 1) A Certificate of Eligibility is required, verifying that the crystal was started on or after the contest start date of **July 1, 2003**, (date may be modified for Centers whose preliminaries are held prior to February) and **grown for a maximum of 3 months**.
- 2) All information must be displayed on a standard, freestanding, tri-fold science fair display board.
- 3) A logbook or journal containing observations and measurements during the crystal's growth must be on the display table.

Recommendations and Guidelines: (Points will be awarded for the following)

- 1) Display board should have diagrams or photographs of the crystal in various stages of growth. Diagrams or photos must be labeled with date and number of days into the growing process. Example: November 15, 2003, Day 1; November 24, 2003, Day 9; etc.
- 2) Display board should have a graphic representation of the growth of the crystal with one axis representing the volume of the growing crystal measured in cm^3 and one axis representing the days of growth.
- 4) The logbook should contain a brief written statement of the procedure and materials used to grow the crystal.

- 5) Entries must be single and separate crystals. **Masses or clumps of crystals will be disqualified.**
- 6) An identification and illustration of lattice type should be included on the display board.

JUDGING:

- 1) A crystal will be judged by size, regularity of shape, clarity, and beauty using a scale of 1 – 5 for each (5 being outstanding and 1 being minimal) for a total of 20 points possible.
- 2) Display boards and logbooks will be collectively awarded 1 - 6 points, depending on completeness. To receive maximum points, logbooks must contain procedures, materials, lattice illustration as well as observations throughout the growth of the crystal. The display board should contain graphs and photos or drawings. Total points possible for logbook and display board combined are 6.
- 3) Points awarded for crystal judging and display board/logbook judging will be combined to determine a **total score**. Highest total score will determine the winner.
- 4) In the event of a tie, duplicate awards will be given.

AWARDS: Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
